Services Provided by Gurdwara Sahib Rules and Responsibilities and Suggested Bhetta (DONATION)

Gurdwara Sahib Charlotte is the Sikh house of worship under The Sikh Heritage Society of Greater Charlotte, a nonprofit religious organization. It serves the sangat by fulfilling their religious, spiritual, and social needs, and it also meets their need to hold PRIVATE EVENTS at the Gurdwara, such as weddings and other Sikh religious permitted functions.

In addition, the Sikh religious tradition, as well as the Gurdwara management, requires that all visitors entering the Gurdwara premises and the Gurdwara observe certain rules and etiquette as stated in a separate handout.

Private ceremonies like weddings

To hold a private ceremonies like weddings, the individual or requesting family/party (the user) is required to book using online form or in person. Advance payment/booking fee is \$ 500, this will be credited to Gurdwara Bhetta listed in next para graph.

If party is unable to afford, please reach out and discuss this with the management for consideration of adjustment of charges.

Gurdwara Sahib will provide facility, sound system, Rumala's etc.

Etiquette: For the sanctity of SGGS and Darbar hall please do not Toss or throw flowers/ petals on the bride/groom during Anand Karaj or thereafter. After Anand Karaj ceremony and distribution of Parshad let the newly wed go down stairs first and

all congratulations, Vadhaeeya, photography, meeting the newly wed and chats etc. should be done downstairs not the Darbar hall.

The security deposit is refundable subject to the compliance with the Gurdwara rules and responsibilities stated below.

The party is required to brings their own supplies for serving food and beverages (e.g., silverware, plates, bowls, glasses, napkins, etc.) as well as cleaning and packing supplies. These are NOT provided by Gurdwara Sahib. Supplies in the cabinets are inventoried; if used, charges will be deducted from the security deposit.

The security deposit will be refunded after all areas and furniture used by the party (the user) have been satisfactorily **cleaned** and **organized**.

Cleaning checklist.

- 1. Return all spaces (areas) as well as furniture to their original state (as before the event) before vacating the Gurdwara premises.
- 2. If any damage occurs party is responsible to repair the damage, or have appropriate amount deducted from the deposit. If repair costs exceed the amount of the deposit, after applying the deposit additional payment will be charged to cover the cost of repair.
- 3. Clean the following areas, including but not limited to:
 - i. Durbar Hall vacuum the carpet and remove the trash.
 - ii. Kitchen
 - a) **clean** the dishes, skillet, ranges, tables, and floors;
 - b) **empty** the trash bins and carry trash bag to designated deposit area;
 - c) **sweep and mop** the floors;
 - d) <u>return</u> all cleaned utensils to their original places; and
 - e) <u>remove</u> any personal food from the refrigerators and cabinets.
 - iii. Langar Hall clean the floor, rugs, tables, and chairs.
 - iv. Restrooms clean toilets, urinals, faucets, trash bins, mirrors, and floors.
 - v. Patio clean the floor, tables, chairs, and trash bins, and roll the awnings.
 - vi. Other common areas return them to a state as before the event.

Akhand Path and Sehej Path

From logistic point of view Gurdwara Sahib will prefer not to have the Akhand Paths. We encourage families to consider having Sehej path instead.

Family/party is required to make reservations through secretary. Family is responsible for arranging Pathis, Langar, their transportation and other needs. Some of the family members should be present at the time when Path is going on at the gurdwara Sahib. Gyani ji will be coordinating Akhand Path/Sehaj Path, reach out to him for any questions.
